NATIONAL WELFARE SCHEMES FOR SPORTSPERSONS (Amended as on 10th October, 2023)

1. The scheme shall be a sub-scheme of the National Welfare Schemes for Sportspersons and be called 'Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay National Welfare Program for Sportspersons.'

DEFINITIONS

- 2. In this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires:
- (a) **'Family'** means the sportsperson's wife or husband, as the case may be, minor sons and unmarried daughters residing with and wholly dependent on him/her, and includes a dependent father, mother, unmarried sisters, minor brothers, adopted sons/daughters subject to the condition that a valid proof of adoption is produced.
- (b) **Executive Committee'** (EC) means the Executive Committee for deciding the quantum of financial assistance to the applicant.
- (c) 'Indigent circumstances' means the circumstances under which the sportsperson or his/her family in distress have no source of income or have an income of less than Rs. 8.00 lakh per annum from all sources and such other circumstances as may be considered by the Ministry to be indigent circumstances. Sportspersons working (only regular employees) in any Central/State/UT Government, Public Sector Enterprises/ Undertakings of Centre/State Government, or Autonomous Bodies of Central/State Government will not be eligible for assistance under the scheme.
- (d) **'Sports'** means the sports and games for which a National Sports Federation duly recognized by the Central Government exists. However, other sports and games, for which a duly recognized National Sports Federation does not exist, can also be covered under the scheme if so decided by the Ministry.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHEME

- 3. The objectives of the scheme 'Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay National Welfare Program for Sportspersons' are:
- (i) To provide suitable assistance to sportspersons now living in indigent circumstances;
- (ii To provide suitable assistance to sportspersons injured during the period of their training for competitions and also during the competitions, depending on the nature of the injury;
- (iii) To provide suitable assistance to sportspersons for medical treatment;
- (iv) To provide suitable assistance to promote the welfare of sportspersons generally in order to alleviate distress among them and their dependents in indigent circumstances;
- (v) To provide assistance to sportspersons living in indigent circumstances for training, procurement of sports equipment, participation in National and International sports events etc.
- (vi) To any other purpose as deemed fit by the Ministry.

4. <u>OUANTUM OF ASSISTANCE AND ELIGIBILITY</u>

4 (i) Quantum of Assistance and Eligibility Criteria for different purposes will be as under:

- 4 (ii) An Executive Committee (EC) comprising of the following members would take into account the full facts and circumstances of each application and decide on the eligibility and the quantum of financial assistance to the applicant:
 - a) Secretary (Sports) Chairperson
 - b) Joint Secretary, (in-charge of the scheme), MYAS
 - c) Financial Advisor, MYAS
 - d) Director (in-charge of the scheme), MYAS
 - e) Three (3) Eminent Sportspersons (nominated*)
- * Three eminent sportspersons shall be nominated by the Minister-in-charge for Youth Affairs and Sports. A nominated member of the Committee shall hold office for a period of 3 years from the date of his/her nomination unless re-nominated at the expiry of that period.
- 4 (iii) Vacancies in the EC shall be filled as and when they arise.
- 4 (iv) The EC shall meet once a month.
- 4 (v) The Executive Committee will recommend name of sportsperson with quantum of assistance for approval by Hon'ble Minister for Youth Affairs & Sports.
- 4 (vi) **Disclosure of information about assistance received from other resources:** Sportspersons or family members of sportspersons applying for assistance from the Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay National Welfare Program for Sportspersons scheme will furnish information about assistance received in kind or cash from any other source for the same purpose or if they receive support from any other scheme of the Ministry.

HOW TO APPLY

- 5(i) Applicant may apply for financial assistance directly through the MIS-DBT portal of the Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (https://dbtyassports.gov.in)
- 5(ii) On receipt of the online application, the Ministry will examine whether the applicant fulfils the eligibility criteria mentioned in point no. 4. (i) above. If required, the Ministry may F.No.K-15013/18/2023-SP-IV

seek a report from the Sports Authority of India (SAI) or any other Government Agency.

- 5 (iii) Online applications submitted by the sportsperson would be made visible in real-time to all stakeholders which can be accessed through the MIS-DBT Portal with valid login credentials.
- 5 (iv) Upon receipt of the application, the Sports Authority of India (SAI) shall promptly undertake the verification process immediately, independent of any subsequent directives from the Ministry. SAI also shall ensure that the verification report is submitted through the MIS-DBT Portal (As per the prescribed format given in the Annexure countersigned by Secretary (SAI)) within 10 working days from the date of receiving the online application.
- 5 (v) The applications seeking assistance will be disposed of in a time-bound manner. All efforts would be made by the Ministry for the disposal of the application within forty-five working days of the receipt of the application.

DISCRETIONARY CLAUSE

6. The Minister-in-Charge for Youth Affairs and Sports may sanction assistance upto Rs.20,00,000 (Rupees Twenty Lakhs only), in deserving cases, even to those, who technically are non-eligible, taking into account full facts and circumstances for each case and for reasons to be recorded in writing.

RELAXATION CLAUSE

7. The Ministry reserves the right to add, relax, amend, alter or revise the clauses/sections/provisions of the Scheme with due approval of the Minister-in-Charge of Youth Affairs & Sports.
